Use the following thoughts and questions to have a spiritual conversation as a family. Don't emphasize having the right answer, but focus on spending time discussing the Word as a family.

## **SCRIPTURE**

Psalm 96:1-13; 2 Corinthians 4:1-6

## **SESSION SUMMARY**

In this week's session, we tried to better understand what we mean when we talk about God's "glory." God's glory has to do with his fame, but more than that, it has to do with His greatness, His goodness, and His beauty, each of which He possesses in infinite, perfect measure. His glory is the display of His infinite perfections. Here are some of the main things we learned from the story:

- God's glory is revealed through worship (Ps. 96:1-9)
- God's glory is revealed through judgment (Ps. 96:10-13)
- God's glory is revealed through His Son (2 Cor. 4:1-6)

## **CONVERSATION QUESTIONS**

- · How can we incorparate musical woriship into our daily lives more?
- · How might it glorify God for us to resist the temptation to be judge and jury ourselves?
- What things might distract us from seeing and appreciating God's glory because they take our focus off of Jesus?

## **FAMILY CHALLENGE**

Challenge each family member to look for one thing this week that expands their view of God's glory. What makes them go, "Wow, God is awesome!"? It could be a lyric in a song, a verse, an observation in creation, etc. At the end of the week, have each person share what they found and discuss why that thing glorifies God.
